

Contest Information

Our Story:

This Contest had its humble beginning in 2012 when it was the Oneida County Aquatic Invasive Species Poster Contest. That year we welcomed 82 posters. Since then, we have grown in the number of posters received and have expanded our contest to include invasive species not only in the water, but also on land, and in wetlands. In addition, we now welcome ALL students throughout Wisconsin. Invasive species do not recognize county lines and neither should this contest!

Poster Divisions:

There are four poster divisions: (1) Grade 4, (2) Grade 5, (3) Grade 6, and (4) Grades 7 & 8.

How to Enter: Entries MUST be received by Wednesday, April 26, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.

Poster entries (with entry forms taped to the back) may be dropped off at any designated drop-off location (Page 6), or mailed to: Oneida County LWCD, Attention: Invasive Species Poster Contest, Courthouse, 1 South Oneida Avenue, P O Box 400, Rhinelander WI 54501. (Do not fold entries)

OR

E-mail a photo of your poster to msadauskas@co.oneida.wi.us. When taking a photo of the poster, please fill the frame and make sure it is clear. This is extremely important. Additionally, a photo of the official entry form must be sent with the poster entry.

Judging:

A panel of judges, with backgrounds in the arts and sciences, will determine the winners. Judging will take place during the week of May 1-5, 2023. Judge's decisions are final. Winners will be notified by Friday, May 5. All posters or photos of posters become the property of Oneida County Land & Water. All qualifying entries will be on display in the hallways on the 2nd floor in the Oneida County Courthouse, and will remain there throughout the month of June in honor of Invasive Species Action Month.

Contest Information - continued

Rules:

- All artwork must be the original work of the individual student.
- Poster size MUST be 11 x 17 inches or smaller. Construction paper is permitted but must be trimmed to 11 x 17 inches. Please measure if you are not sure.
- Posters can be on any color paper; paper must be un-lined.
- Photos cannot be used on posters.
- Any coloring materials may be used (i.e. crayons, watercolors, chalk, markers, etc.).
- No stamps or stickers may be used.
- Please do not put your name on the front of your poster!
- If you are sending a photo, fill the frame and make sure it is clear.



Helpful Hints for Students:

Judging Criteria

- √ 40% Message is effective
- √ 20% Student shows understanding of topic
- √ 20% Universal appeal
- √ 10% Follows contest rules
- √ 10% Originality/Creativity

OUR GOAL

To educate 4th - 8th grade students about aquatic, terrestrial, and wetland invasive species that impact our lands and waters of Wisconsin. We encourage students to nurture their interest for the visual arts, science and environmental conservation.

Copyrights

Be aware of copyrights. Copyrights are a protection by U.S. law for creators of original work. If you see this symbol (©) on any piece of work, you **CANNOT** use it on your poster. Use your own ideas and/or drawings.

Remember

- ◆ Use the *Official Entry Form* (Page 7).
- Choose a brief, catchy message or slogan for your poster. Slogans are also awarded a prize.
- Use colors to capture and hold attention.
- Don't use photos, stickers, or stamps on your poster.
- Don't try to include too many ideas or activities in your artwork. Simple is often better.



Prizes:

- ♦ Winners are chosen in four divisions: (1) Grade 4; (2) Grade 5; (3) Grade 6; & (4) Grade 7/8.
- ♦ Students in each division compete for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place Trophies, Honorable Mention and Best Slogan Ribbons and 1 Best of Show Ribbon.
- ◆ Each 1st place winner's class wins too! A local invasive Species Team representative can visit your classroom (subject to teacher approval and coordination) to present individual student awards and a Classroom Trophy.
- ◆ Each 1st place winner's school receives a field guide for their school library.
- Participating teachers have a chance to win one of THREE \$25 gift cards.

So, get your friends to enter and you could **ALL** be winners!
